LDF Peter Christensen Dental Center will be closed until July 30, 2020

LAC DU FLAMBEAU—July 20, 2020—The Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians Tribal Council announced a PCDC employee tested positive for COVID-19.

Based on initial investigations, it's believed the risk of exposure to be unknown. The employee may have had contact with others and is in 14-day quarantine. Contact tracing was conducted on any patients and/or employees that may have been in contact with the employee.

The entire PCDC facility is receiving additional sanitizing beyond the safety measures and cleaning procedures already in place and recommended by the CDC and local health authorities.

Staff will be reaching out to patients to reschedule appointments; if you have emergency dental services needed please contact PCHC at 715-588-3371.
