**NOTICE** is hereby given that the **Primary Election** will be held in the Village of Lac du Flambeau, Wisconsin, on **September 4, 2012** for the purpose of electing Tribal Officers.

### **PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT, AND FOUR (4) COUNCIL MEMBERS** **(This is for a two (2) year term.)**

According to the Constitution and By-Laws: 'ARTICLE IV, SECTION 6, NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS: "Any member of the Tribe who is eighteen (18) years of age or over and who presents himself at the polls on Election Day shall be entitled to vote."

The Tribal Code, Chapter 11.112(1), states: (1) A primary election shall be held in the event that more than eight (8) candidates are nominated for the Tribal Council seats or more than two (2) candidates are nominated for any officer position. If a primary election is necessary for any position, it shall be held for all positions."
