UPDATE: CORONAVIRUS CASES ON RESERVATION REMAIN AT ZERO
Tribal Building Access Limited, Coronavirus Hotline, Check Processing Updates

AS OF THIS UPDATE, 12 p.m., Tuesday, March 18, 2020: There continues to be zero confirmed Coronavirus cases on the Reservation. If there is a confirmed case of the virus in Lac du Flambeau, we will announce it. **We continue to plan and prepare for the virus reaching here eventually.**

Coronavirus Tribal Response Team continues to actively work on response efforts to slow the progression of the Coronavirus, if it arrives here. The team meets daily and is working throughout the day to monitor and make decisions to keep the community safe based on the best available information. The team is working with federal and state agencies to coordinate our response too.

Tribe will limit access to all Tribal Buildings—unless you have an appointment. Please call ahead to determine if you need to visit in-person. Staff at each building will help you decide.
