Starting Monday, March 16, 2020; Peter Christensen Health Center will change patient flow will be changed to promote the health and well-being of patients, staff and visitors as well as containing the spread of influenza like illnesses. Due to the limited amount of supplies, Coronavirus testing is NOT available for the general public on request. Similar to testing for other infectious diseases like the flu, an evaluation will be conducted by your health care provider.

COVID-19 Response Team Activated

The Tribal COVID-19 Response Team has been activated and actively working on response efforts to slow the progression of the Coronavirus. The Team meets on a daily basis.
