LDF TRIBE ANNOUNCES PRE-CAUTIONARY PUBLIC SCHOOL CLOSURE SUPPORT
LDF Public School & Zaasijiwan Head Start Closed Until March 30, 2020

After listening to concerns about COVID-19 (Corona Virus) from medical staff, law enforcement and other professional staff, Tribal Council supports the closing of the LDF Public School and Zaasijiwan Head Start for an additional two weeks beginning March 16, 2020. The official resolution follows.

As new developments happen, we will continue to communicate to ensure Tribal Members and Tribal Staff are informed. Please know we are making decisions based on recommendations of health officials while balancing our responsibility to both serve our community and protect our community, including those most vulnerable to this virus. Thank you for your consideration of this.

RESOLUTION NO. 92(20)

- WHEREAS,** the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians ("Tribe"), is a federally recognized Indian tribe organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, 25 U.S.C. §461 et. seq.; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article III, Section 1 of the Lac du Flambeau Constitution ("Constitution"), the governing body of the Tribe is the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** Article VI of the Constitution sets forth the Powers and Duties of the Tribal Council, and Section 1(a) of Article VI authorizes the Tribal Council to "...protect the health, security, and general welfare of the Tribe"; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has listened to concerns from Medical Staff, Police Staff and other Professional staff on the potential spread of the Coronavirus and wishes to show their support in closing the Lac du Flambeau Public School including the Zaasijiwan Head Start; now, therefore be it finally
- RESOLVED,** by this Council, by Poll Vote, hereby approves their support in closing the Lac du Flambeau Public School and Zaasijiwan Head Start for an additional two weeks beginning March 16, 2020.

CERTIFICATION
