**A. TITLE OF POSITION:** Fitness Center Associate (Part time, Weekends Only)

**B. DEPARTMENT:** Wellness Center (Fitness Center)

**C. SUPERVISOR'S TITLE:** Fitness Center Supervisor

**D. DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:** The Weekend Fitness Associate will ensure the fitness center operates safely, cleanly, and efficiently for members during Saturday and Sunday hours. This role acts as the primary point of contact, focusing on front desk service, facility maintenance, and member safety. Be knowledgeable of good physical fitness. Provide general guidance and display a positive attitude toward others. Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Responsible for opening and closing the fitness center and preparing the gym for daily operations.
2. Registering members for use of the Fitness Center and any other member-related paperwork, including data entry of member's confidential personal information.
3. Welcome fitness patrons and potential members.
4. Present information on membership and provide tours of the fitness area.
5. Cleaning and maintenance of fitness equipment, mirrors, and floor areas.
6. Answer questions pertaining to the fitness area in person and on the telephone.
7. Provide quality customer service.
8. Monitor reception area and/or gym area during fitness hours to assure members are following safety protocols, using equipment properly and adhering to gym policies.
9. Direct fitness patrons to appropriate equipment and machine locations.
10. Provide general guidance to members on the use of the equipment.
11. Must be helpful, respectful and display a positive attitude toward others and fitness.
12. Assist in developing departmental policies as necessary.
13. Maintains strictest confidentiality according to HIPAA standards and upholds confidentiality working with members.
14. Participates in mandatory trainings and completes assigned trainings.
15. Understands the principle of Quality Improvement and participates in appropriate QI projects.
16. Works toward achieving implementation of AAAHC certifications and conducts appropriate follow up.
17. All other duties as assigned.

**E. POSITION RELATIONSHIPS:**

1. **Internal:** Frequent contact with staff, patrons, and other building employees.
2. **External:** Frequent contact with potential customers and other physical fitness related personnel.

**F. SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:** None

**G. SUPERVISION RECEIVED:** Fitness Center Supervisor

**H. EDUCATION:** High school diploma or equivalent is required. Will be required to attain Heartsaver Certification and successfully maintain thereafter.

**I. EXPERIENCE:** Physical fitness background with knowledge of the use of exercise machines and equipment. Must be able to work unsupervised.

**J. SKILLS:**

1. Must have basic computer skills.
2. Must have good verbal and written communication skills.
3. Must be dependable, hardworking, friendly, and courteous.
4. Previous customer service skills preferred.

**K. WORKING ENVIRONMENT:**

1. **Work Conditions:** Must be able to walk and stand for a reasonable duration during work shift. Able to lift as least 50 lbs.
2. **Exposure to Hazards:** Must use “safety first” concept at all times when working with machines and equipment.
3. **Physical Requirements:** Very physical position at times when working with members on machines and equipment.

**L. BEHAVIOR:** The vision, goals and objectives of the Lac du Flambeau Band of the Lake Superior Chippewa Indians requires the Fitness Center Associate to perform in both a professional and personable manner. The manner in which the employee relates to fellow employees, customers and visitors is considered parallel in importance to technical knowledge and ability. Respect and consideration given to the dignity of each customer, visitor and fellow employee is a requisite of successful job performance. Any attitude or behavior that will tarnish the name or reputation of the Lac du Flambeau Tribe will not be tolerated and is subject to disciplinary action.

**M. OTHER:** Demonstrate a strong commitment to cultural beliefs and values of the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians and the governing Tribal Council. Practices cultural sensitivity at all times, recognizing the respective diverse work styles within the organization and the Lac du Flambeau community. Must submit to a drug test prior to commencing employment and random testing thereafter. Criminal background check required applicable to the job description. Employee must provide proof of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, Hep B, and pertussis/Tdap at the time of employment and submit to a TB test. As an employee of the Tribe, he/she will be subject to the Policies and Procedures of the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians.
