General Description: The primary responsibility of this position is to become familiar with traditional knowledge of wild rice harvesting, processing, and community sharing. The Wild Rice Technician will assist the Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program Manager in sharing this knowledge with community members, through demonstrations and outreach within the LDF Community to help revitalize the importance of wild rice health living, wildlife enhancement and water quality protection.

Qualifications: High School diploma or equivalent is required. Experience in wild rice gathering and processing techniques or willing to learn these skills. Experience in public speaking or making presentations preferred. Computer word processing application is necessary. Knowledge in boat operations and safety preferred. Valid WI Driver's license, liability insurance, and must be insurable, is required.

Salary: \$15.00-\$18.00/hr. depending on qualifications.

Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians Nonexempt Position Description

- **A. TITLE OF POSITION:** Wild Rice Enhancement Technician (Part-time, Seasonal)
- **B. DEPARTMENT:** Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program
- C. SUPERVISOR'S TITLE: Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program Manager
- **D. DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:** The primary responsibility of this position is to become familiar with the traditional knowledge and practice of wild rice harvesting, processing, and community sharing. The Wild Rice Enhancement Technician will then share this knowledge with community members by conducting demonstrations and outreach within the LDF Community to help revitalize the importance of Wild Rice for healthy living, wildlife enhancement and water quality protection. Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:
 - 1. Research and map traditional wild rice gathering areas on the LDF Reservation and coordinate efforts to begin restoration plans of these areas.
 - 2. Meet and update Natural Resource staff to discuss scientific aspects of water quality and shoreline development within the LDF Reservation.
 - 3. Exchange information on threatened wild rice areas within the LDF Reservation and Ceded Territory with staff from GLIFWC.
 - 4. Work collaboratively with other State and Federal agencies on issues related to wild rice and off reservation wild rice projects and management practices.
 - 5. Will be the lead person in continued wild rice re-seeding efforts on existing wild rice reseeding waters within the LDF Reservation.
 - 6. Work with Wild Rice Chiefs, attend Tribal Wild Rice Chiefs meetings, joint State/Tribal wild rice meetings, Voight Task Force meetings when necessary.
 - 7. Gather wild rice during the harvest season to share with community as directed by the LDF Tribal Council.
 - 8. Coordinate efforts with Tribal Natural Resource Programs to develop a Wild Rice Management Plan which shall include wild rice restoration projects within the LDF Reservation.
 - 9. Construct and maintain a Wild Rice Camp on the LDF Reservation during the gathering season.
 - 10. Provide demonstrations on hand harvesting and processing to local Head Start, Grade School, and College Institutions to express the importance of wild rice to the Ojibwe People.
 - 11. Develop video documentation of program accomplishments/activities for community, schools, and media to emphasize respect, protection, and enhancing of wild rice.
 - 12. Annual participation at the Wild Rice Fest event is required.
 - 13. Other duties as assigned.

E. POSITION RELATIONSHIPS:

- 1. Internal: Work closely with Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program Manager to implement goals and objectives of the Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program. Will provide assistance regularly to Natural Resource staff on a regular basis and monthly meetings with oversight committee.
- **2. External:** General public for demonstrations. Will attend meetings/seminars and gather information on Wild Rice Enhancement and protection.
- F. SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES: None
- G. SUPERVISION RECEIVED: Wild Rice Cultural Enhancement Program Manager
- **H. EDUCATION:** High School diploma or equivalent is required.
- I. EXPERIENCE: Experience in wild rice gathering and processing techniques or willing to learn these skills. Experience in public speaking or making presentations preferred. Computer word processing application is necessary. Knowledge in boat operations and safety preferred. Valid WI Driver's license, liability insurance, and must be insurable, is required.

J. SKILLS:

- 1. Experience with speaking in public or making public presentations.
- 2. Understanding of electronic devices (GPS), motor boat operations and chain saw.

K. WORKING ENVIRONMENT:

- 1. Work Conditions: Office setting-reviewing and entering wild rice information/record keeping on computer. Outdoor setting-familiar with canoeing/boating practices and outdoor work.
- **2. Exposure to Hazards:** Exposure to cold, rain, heat, etc.
- 3. Physical Requirements: Must be able to stand and sit for extended periods of time.
- L. BEHAVIOR: The vision, goals and objectives of the Lac du Flambeau Band of the Lake Superior Chippewa Indians requires the Wild Rice Enhancement Technician to perform in both a professional and personable manner. The manner in which the employee relates to fellow employees, customers and visitors is considered parallel in importance to technical knowledge and ability. Respect and consideration given to the dignity of each customer, visitor and fellow employee is a requisite of successful job performance. Any attitude or behavior that will tarnish the name or reputation of the Lac du Flambeau Tribe will not be tolerated and is subject to disciplinary action.
- M. OTHER: Demonstrate a strong commitment to cultural beliefs and values of the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians and the governing Tribal Council. Practices cultural sensitivity at all times, recognizing the respective diverse work styles within the organization and the Lac du Flambeau community. Must submit to a drug test prior to commencing employment and random testing thereafter. Criminal background check required applicable to the job description. As an employee of the Tribe, he/she will be
