

Parent & Child Open Gym Policies

- Parent or legal guardian must remain in the gym and supervise at all times
- Children must be K-12th grade
- One adult may supervise no more than five children
- Only the gym is open for open gym hours. Participants must remain in the designated gym area unless entering or exiting the building.
- All participants must sign a waiver before entering

Supervision & Safety

- Adults must maintain hands-on, within-arm's-reach supervision
- No coaching or spotting from staff; parents are responsible for their child's safety
- Children must use equipment as intended

- Any damaged, loose, or malfunctioning equipment must be reported to staff immediately.

- No rough play, running under equipment, or unsafe behavior
- Keep all bags, food, and drinks off the gym floor (water allowed)
- No gum or Candy allowed

Equipment Rules

- Certain equipment may be off-limits unless staff-approved
- Mats or portable equipment should not be moved without staff permission
- No Outside or Personal Equipment
 - Outside equipment of any kind is not allowed, including balls, mats, weights, toys, or training devices.
 - Only facility-owned and approved equipment may be used during open gym.
 - Personal items that could interfere with safety—such as scooters, hoverboards, bats, sticks, baseballs, footballs or similar objects—are prohibited.
 - Exceptions may be granted only with prior approval from management for medical or accessibility needs.

- The facility is not responsible for loss, damage, or storage of personal equipment brought in against policy.
- Gym must be left the way it was found. All equipment must be put away and garbage picked up

Attire

- All participants must wear clean, closed-toe, non-marking athletic shoes.
- Shoes that leave scuff marks, have hard soles, or are worn for outdoor use are not permitted.
- Staff may deny participation if footwear does not meet safety or floor-protection standards.
- Bare feet, sandals, boots, and cleats are not allowed.

Health & Cleanliness

- Do not attend if you or your child is sick
- All spills or accidents should be reported immediately

Behavior & Conduct

- Respect staff instructions at all times
- Disruptive or unsafe behavior may result in removal from the building.
- Be considerate of other families and share equipment

Liability & Responsibility

- Parents assume full responsibility for supervising their child's participation
